IRREGULAR ADJECTIVES

the irregular adjectives are those that change

POSITIVE FORM	COMPARATIVE	SUPERLATIVE
Good – Well	Better	The best
Bad	Worse	The worst
Much – Many	More	The most
Little	Less	The least
Far	Further – Farther	The furthest- the farther (people and things) - (distance and time)
Old	Older – Elder	The oldest – The elder (people, age and things) - (seniority of people)

Step 2: OPEN your workbooks on page 62 and do exercises 2 and 3.

Step 3: Write sentences into your notebook using some of the adjectives from the chart as in the example: (Napiši stavke, v katerih uporabiš nekatere pridevnike iz tabele kot je to napisano v primeru)

GOOD – lettuce, tomato, cucumber

A cucumber is good, lettuce is better but tomato is the best.

Good – English, Slovenian, Maths (school subjects)

Bad – swimming, running, skiing (as sports)

Much – milk, coffee, water (količina- neštevnici samostalnik)

Many – boys, girls, adults (količina.števnici samostalnik)

Far – (distance) Ljubljana, Zagreb, London
