
Today, we are going to talk about one of the future tenses. The "going to" future tense.

I'll switch to Slovenian just to make sure you all understand

Tole si prepišite v zvezke:

Torej, prihodnjik "going to" se uporablja takrat, kadar hočemo povedati, da imamo za prihodnost neke načrte ali namen

(It is used for **FUTURE PLANS**).



Tvorimo ga takole:

osebek / glagol "be" v sedanjiku / going to / glagol v nedoločniku /"ostalo" (am, is, are)

He	is	going to	play	football.
My friends	are	going to	eat	lunch.
1	am	going to	steal	a bike.

Trdilno, nikalno ali vprašalno obliko tvorimo z glagolom "be".

He is going to play. I am going to play.

He isn't going to play. I am not going to play.

Is he going to play?

Am I going to play?

Pazite na to, da mora vsak stavek v tem času vsebovati izraz "going to".

I'm going to play - igral bom

I'm going to sing - pel bom

He's going to eat - jedel bo

He's going to go – šel bo

Torej, če bo glavni glagol v stavku "go", potem zadeva izgleda takole:

I am going to go to London. (Šel bom v London.)

I am not going to go to London.

Am I going to go to London?

Got it? Good 😊
