

Hello everyone!

We hope you had nice holidays and are ready to do some English. You are going to study the **SECOND CONDITIONAL**.



1. Open your book on **page 82** and **do the questionnaire in exercise 2**. Check your score to find out your level of honesty 😊. You do not need to share this with your teacher.
2. Open your notebook. Put down the title **THE SECOND CONDITIONAL**.

Write down the following examples:

If I found someone's diary, I **would read** it.

If someone asked me for advice, I **wouldn't give** my honest opinion.

If I could go to school tomorrow, I **would be** very happy.

The structure of the second conditional is:

If + Past Simple, would (not) + verb

Now try and write down **3 more examples**. Translate them into Slovenian.

When translating to English, be careful – *would* is only used in the MAIN CLAUSE!

(V slovenščini uporabimo besedo »bi« v pogojnem in v glavnem stavku).



Wait a second? Does that »sound« right?

Conditional Exception!

Normally we say:
I was ...
He/She/It was ...

In the 2nd conditional, it is more common to say:
If I were ...
If he/she/it were ...

* **was** is not incorrect, but **were** is more common



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3. Open your books on **page 83** and do **exercises 4a and 4b** into your notebook.

Are you confused? Do you find the second conditional difficult? Don't worry. You will get additional explanation on Thursday's Zoom session.
